Please note that French 140(French Literature in English Translation) require prior approval to count toward the minor.

ALL COURSEWORK MUST BE DONE IN FRENCH. ALL COURSES MUST BE TAKEN FOR A LETTER GRADE. COURSES TAKEN PASS/NOT PASS WILL NOT COUNT TOWARD THE MINOR.

At least a "C" average (2.0 GPA) is required in the upper-division courses taken in satisfaction of the minor.

When the student is completing the last French course(s) for the Minor, they should complete and sign the Petition for Completion of L&S Minor, available online from the College of Letters and Science website. Paper Petitions are also available from the Undergraduate Major Adviser in 4209 Dwinelle. The student is held responsible for the timely completion and submission of these forms.

According to University guidelines, a maximum of one course that is used towards the student's minor may also be used toward a major program. Course Overlaps require approval from the student's major adviser in order to confirm completion of the Minor. It is the responsibility of the student to inform his/her major department of any course to be counted toward both the student's major and the French minor.
